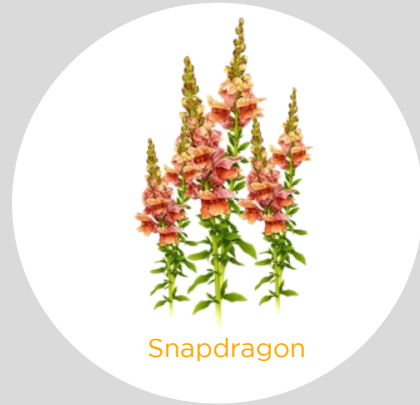
Plant time indoors:	Jul - Nov	Plant time indoors:	September to April
Transplant time	<p>Tomatoes - Seedlings should be 20 - 25cm tall</p> <p>Carrots - Tops of carrots should be 10cm tall</p>	Harvest time:	<p>Basil - when first leaves appear within 10 - 12 weeks</p> <p>Rocket - when leaves are 7 - 10cm within 25 - 35 days of germination</p>
Harvest time:	<p>Tomatoes - 8 - 17 weeks</p> <p>Carrots - 8 - 12 weeks</p>

Plant time indoors:	End of winter
Transplant time :	Early Spring - Summer

Plant time indoors:	Winter
Transplant time:	Late Spring - Summer

WHEN TO PLANT YOUR GROWING PAPER



Thyme

Plant time indoors:	Spring to Summer
Transplant time:	Once a small bush has been established, divide roots in early spring and transplant
Harvest time:	As soon as the plant is established and leaves are visible



Chilli

Plant time indoors:	Winter - Early Spring
Transplant time:	6 - 8 weeks after seeds are planted
Harvest time:	Cayenne Peppers should be ready to harvest in 70 - 80 days or when the peppers are about 10 - 15cm long.



Parsley

Plant time indoors:	Spring to Summer
Transplant time:	Parsley has a taproot and does not transplant well.
Harvest time:	Harvest leaves from late autumn throughout year



Butter Lettuce

Plant time indoors:	Early Spring
Transplant time:	When they have 2 to 3 true leaves
Harvest time:	Can be picked 30 - 60 days after sowing

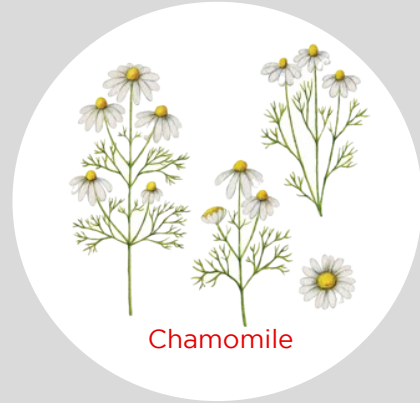


WHEN TO PLANT YOUR GROWING PAPER



Lemon Balm

Plant time indoors:	Spring - Summer
Transplant time:	Only in the following Autumn to Spring. Divide into clumps and transplant
Harvest time:	Throughout the year as soon as true leaves and flowers appear



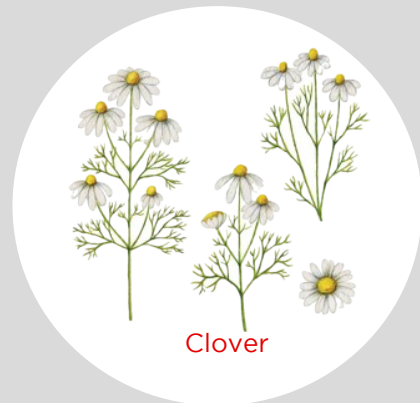
Chamomile

Plant time indoors:	Spring
Transplant time:	When thick patches have formed divide growing patches and cut off leaves with roots to transplant
Harvest time:	Pick the flowers when in full



Korean Mint

Plant time indoors:	Spring
Transplant time:	Rhizomes will readily sprout roots and stems when replanted any time of the year, but Mint also makes a good container plant.
Harvest time:	Leaves can be picked throughout the year, but lose their best aroma once flowers appear.



Clover

Plant time indoors:	Spring - Summer
Transplant time:	Transplanted once plant is established seedling.
Harvest time:	Harvest at early bloom and use as mulch.
